Camping

Scouts and leaders from each pack will camp together as a patrol. Each patrol will be assigned a campsite. Tents for the scouts should be pitched on one side of the site and leader tents on the other side with any parent/family tents in the middle. Scouts are permitted to share tents with each other, but not with leaders.

Meals

Each pack will need to plan for, bring and prepare their meals for the campout. This is a great opportunity for the scouts to earn the **Cast Iron Chef** Adventure Pin. It is suggested that scouts eat dinner before arriving on Friday or bring food which is ready to eat. Scouts will need to prepare breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday and a quick breakfast on Sunday. It is suggested that you plan a cold lunch and save the cooking for breakfast and dinner. There will be running water at the park, but access to electricity may be limited. Fires for cooking are permitted, but they must be up off of the ground such as in a camp grill. Activities

Each scout will have the opportunity to earn 2 Adventure Pins. A link will be sent out so each scout can request which Adventure they want. In addition to the adventure pins, there will be several theme related activities hosted by local Troops. Each scout will also have the opportunity to participate in range activities. Scouts will be asked for the first, second and third choices of these classes. The specific classes that are scheduled will depend on the number of scouts that request each one and on the availability of instructors.

This campout is also an opportune time for scouts to work with their leaders on earning the “Cast Iron Chef” adventure and the “Outdoorsman” Adventure. Scouts can also earn some of the requirements for “Scouting Adventure” on this campout.
